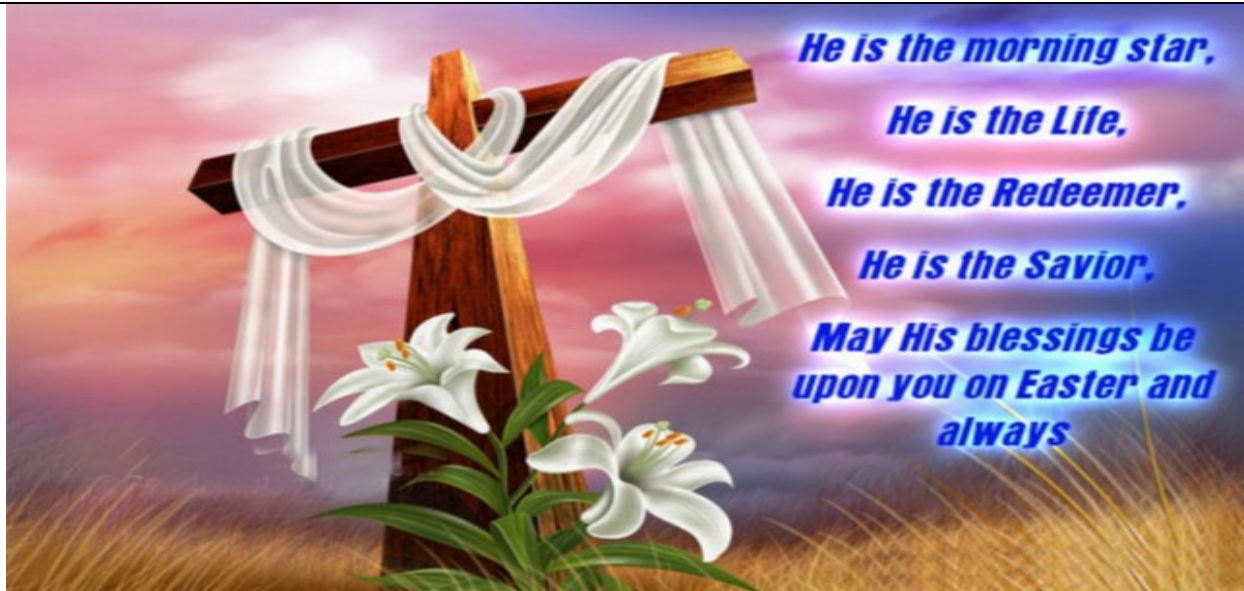

Just to share what God did through your gifts and the gifts of others in this County and across the country and the world.

In 2018 in Alamance and Caswell counties 17,572 shoeboxes were packed and collected.

In the region of the Carolinas 864,464 shoebox gifts were collected. In the United States 8,801,607 gifts and Worldwide 10,623,760 shoeboxes were collected and distributed by local partners in over 100 countries. These numbers represent children who received a gift that represents Christ love for them. In 2019 let us do our part to reach more children for Jesus Christ.

For the month of April we will be collecting clothing items: Toboggans, gloves, underwear, socks, t-shirts, small purses, scarves and any other items of clothing. Remember all items we collect are to be new items.

Remember our goal for 2019 is 175 shoeboxes.
