## OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD

As the year 2018 has passed, God enabled us to collect 156 shoeboxes which exceeded our goal. These shoeboxes went to the countries of Angola, Southern Africa, Cameroon, Central Africa, and Columbia, South America and to Hard to Reach Areas.

The following is the testimony of a young man named Arthur in one of the Hard to Reach Areas who received a shoebox:

### Showing Love and Truth

**Arthur was a young man who lived in a very war torn area with many militants often killing the people in the village. One day a box came filled with brightly colored shoeboxes. In these boxes were things that most of the children had never seen or had, pencils, soap, crayons and paper. We take these things for granted. Arthur received his shoebox along with other children. In the box was the Greatest Journey Ever booklet explaining to Arthur and the other children how to receive Christ as their Savior. Arthur was so thrilled to have paper and pencils so he could write down things. Not long after this Arthur and many of the children were killed in an ambush attack by militants. When his mother looked on his paper he told how he had the day before asked Jesus into his heart as his Savior.**

**We will focus in the month of February on soap and washcloths, combs and brushes, deodorant, and toothbrushes.**

**Remember our goal for 2019 is 175 shoeboxes.**
