The question has been asked why it costs \$9.00 to process each shoe box.

Let's just imagine that you pack your own shoebox with various items. Then you put that shoebox in another box and seal it up. Then you go to the Post Office to mail it to let's say Columbia, South America. The Post man will then weigh it, look at the size, and the distance it is going. On an average that one shoebox would cost you over \$25.00 to mail and that is a low estimate.

The question then to consider is what is the value of a child? At what price are we willing to pay for a child to hear the Gospel through the simple gift of a shoe box? We want to thank everyone who has always been so generous in donating items for the boxes and monies to send the shoe boxes.

We will be collecting school supplies for the month of July and August. Pencils, pens, crayons, colored pencils, erasers, pencil sharpeners, calculators, small spiral notebooks, color books, small books, rulers and stickers. Please remember all items must fit in the shoebox.

**Remember our goal for 2019 is 175 shoeboxes.**
