OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD

Sorina Riddle was a recipient of a shoebox in Romania. She recalls the day she received this gift. She was relating her story to a group of Christian bikers who came to the Billy Graham library in Charlotte. They came from across the country, more than 850 bikers. These men and women brought more than 1500 shoeboxes for Operation Christmas Child.

Sorina relates to them the time her and her brother received their boxes. They came from an extremely poor family who had very little clothes to keep them warm. When she opened her box that she had prayed for, it was more than she ever imagined. There were gloves, a warm hat and a scarf. Those gifts and the love they revealed to her about God led her to accept Christ as her Savior.

She told the bikers, as well as to us, pack the boxes, say a prayer over them, and trust God to put that box in the hands of the child who needs it. Sorina to this day still has her hat, scarf and gloves to remind her of God's love.

For the month of May we will continue to collect soap and toothbrushes, (No Toothpaste) underwear and socks. We will also be collecting small hammers, screwdrivers, nails and screws. For our fishing kits we need hooks, sinkers, floaters, and lures.

Remember our goal for 2019 is 175 shoeboxes.
