# Notice! Notice! Notice! FROM DEACON'S MEETING

Pastor Gene met with the deacons on Monday night, April 27 to discuss procedures for reopening the church once NC Governor Cooper lifts the current restrictions. Based on these restrictions the earliest date we can reopen the church is May 10, 2020. (Mother's Day). We need to remain aware, however, that the Governor may extend this date at any time. We assume the authorization for churches to resume worship services will recommend the continuing use of face mask and social distancing among the congregation. For the safety of the congregation, we encourage each of us to adhere to these recommendations. Pastor Gene has secured a supply of hospital grade face masks, which will be made available at the church door for anyone not having a mask. These masks are washable for continuing use, so until this restriction is lifted, please bring it with you each Sunday.

We encourage that we all refrain from congregating (hugging or shaking hands) while entering or exiting the church. You will notice that for safety purposes we have suspended fellowship time from our worship services. To assist in proper distancing while exiting the church, we request that you remain in your row until prompted by an usher to exit. Offering plates will be placed at the back of the sanctuary for collection of your tithes and offerings.

At this time we plan to resume Sunday school activities on the day that the church is reopened. However, it is recommended that all committee meetings be limited to those of a critical nature and that masks and distancing safety guidelines be followed.

With your help and cooperation, we can make our worship time as safe as possible during this trying time. However, the best solution is to just stay home if you have any possible symptoms of the virus such as a fever, sneezing or cough.

# **Evangelism Is Her Passion**

Deborah Warner serves as chaplain—as well as school nurse and music teacher for third and fourth graders—at Florida Christian School (FCS) in Miami. In addition to serving as the <u>Operation Christmas Child</u> project leader at her school, she also <u>volunteers year-round</u> as a prayer mobilization coordinator.

As the 1,100 students of FCS packed 1,331 shoeboxes in 2017, many were recovering from the effects of Hurricane Irma. Some lost roofs; others had trees fall on their homes, and most were without power for a week or more. Still, they committed to send gifts to children in need around the world.

About 60 percent of students at Florida Christian School come from unbelieving families. Their parents simply want them to have a private education. But the Lord has used Deborah and Operation Christmas Child—both the project and its promotional resources—to encourage, motivate, and even lead children at FCS to salvation.

"As a result," Deborah said, "kids have said, 'I want to give Jesus my heart. I want Him to be my Lord and Savior.""

"It's working on both ends. Recipients of these boxes are getting saved, and at my school at least, kids are getting saved."

We will continue to collect soap, washcloths, toothbrushes, and hair items for the month of May. As always a complete list of items we collect are in the vestibule to be donated all year.
