

What is so special about a shoebox gift?

Pastor Gadi was returning from passing out shoebox gifts when he saw two boys selling walnuts by the side of the road. He saw an opportunity to share with the boys about Jesus. Amir, one of the boys, listened excitedly as the Pastor told of what Jesus had done for them. When the Pastor was finished sharing with the boys the Gospel message, Amir told him "I believe Jesus came to save me."

The Pastor had several shoeboxes left and gave them to the boys and Amir asked the Pastor to call him and his family. Several weeks later Pastor Gadi was back in the area where Amir lived. He called Amir's family. When talking with his father he knew something was wrong. Amir's father shared that Amir had been hit by a car at his roadside stand and killed. The Pastor asked if he could come see them. The family told how excited Amir had been when he came home that day with his shoebox. He also told them about Jesus and the family received Christ as their Savior.

The family keeps the shoebox gift as a reminder that their son is now with Jesus and that they also received the special message of salvation and many people were saved because of Amir's death
